IEC 61439 is a standard developed by the International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) that covers design verification for low-voltage electrical products and assemblies. RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) limits the use of specific hazardous materials in electrical products. Quality busbars typically undergo multiple inspections, including: These tests ensure compliance. The purpose of this method is to verify the functionalities of a Metal Enclosed Busbar. The IEC 61439. The table, in addition to giving specifications regarding the maximum thickness of the busbar, the maximum current and the maximum nominal voltage, distinguishes between busbars mounted in a "Face to Face" or "Edge to Edge" arrangement. Re-torque after initial 100-hr energised period. 3 severity criteria: DT 1-10 °C = Monitor; 11-20 °C = Investigate; > 20 °C = Immediate action. Scan under $\pm 40\%$ rated load for valid results.
