Preparation and Cable Handling

Fusion Splicing Sequence



Fusion splicing permanently joins fibers by melting their ends with an electric arc. Align fibers precisely using either manual V-groove holders or automatic alignment systems. After splicing, protect the joint with a heat shrink sleeve. In series splicing, repeat this process for each fiber in sequence, ensuring that all 24 cores are spliced in the correct order to maintain network integrity .

Splice Closure Selection

Use a 24-core fiber optic splice closure to house and protect the spliced fibers. Options include mini horizontal closures or inline closures, which provide IP68-rated protection against dust, moisture, and environmental stress. Pre-organize fibers in color-coded trays to reduce splicing errors and improve efficiency. Closures should allow for easy maintenance and re-entry without compromising the seal .

Fiber Management and Testing

Lay fibers evenly in the splice trays, securing them with nylon ties or clips. Ensure that the fiber bend radius is maintained to prevent signal loss. After splicing, perform optical testing such as OTDR or insertion loss measurements to verify the quality of each splice. Proper labeling and documentation of each fiber in series splicing help with future troubleshooting and network expansion .
