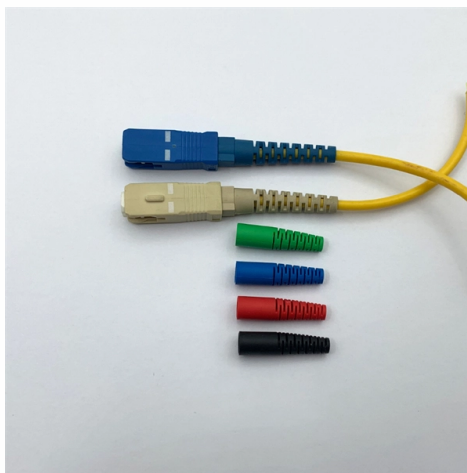


5 Types of Network Patch Panels

1. Ethernet Patch Panels

Ethernet patch panels, also called copper or LAN patch panels, are used to terminate and manage twisted-pair network cables. They support Cat5e, Cat6, Cat6a, and Cat7 cables and are available in loaded (pre-installed ports) or unloaded (blank ports) configurations. Loaded panels are ideal when all ports are in use, while unloaded panels allow flexibility for future expansion. They can be shielded (STP) or unshielded (UTP) depending on the level of electromagnetic interference in the environment .

2. Fiber Optic Patch Panels

Fiber optic patch panels are essential for high-speed data transmission in data centers and enterprise networks. They support single-mode and multi-mode fiber connections and can be rack-mounted or wall-mounted. These panels facilitate optical connections using LC, SC, or ST connectors and are designed to manage fiber cables efficiently while minimizing signal loss .

3. Audio/Video Patch Panels

Audio/video (AV) patch panels are used for routing AV signals in professional setups. They support formats like HDMI, coaxial, and other AV standards. These panels simplify identification and maintenance by clearly labeling ports and segregating cables, which is particularly useful in environments with multiple AV devices or CCTV systems .

4. Shielded vs. Unshielded Patch Panels

Patch panels can be classified based on cable shielding. Shielded patch panels (STP) include a metal layer to block electromagnetic interference, suitable for industrial or high-EMI environments. Unshielded patch panels (UTP) are lighter, cost-effective, and ideal for offices or small data centers with minimal interference .

5. Pre-Loaded vs. Blank Keystone Patch Panels

Pre-loaded patch panels come with connectors installed during manufacturing, allowing faster deployment and consistent connection quality. Blank keystone panels provide empty ports for users to install connectors as needed, offering flexibility for custom setups or future upgrades .
