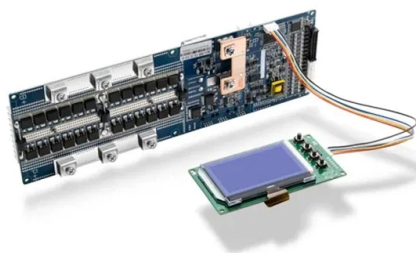

- **Power and Cooling:** High-speed optical modules consume more power (2-5W per module), which can increase operational costs in large deployments .

Alternatives and Cost Management

For short distances ($\leq 3\text{m}$), DAC (Direct Attach Copper) cables are very inexpensive and low-power. For medium distances (5-30m), AOC (Active Optical Cables) offer a balance of cost and flexibility. Optical transceivers are mandatory for distances over 100m, where cost is highest but flexibility and reach are maximized .
