Cable trays provide a structured pathway for electrical cables, allowing for safe routing, support, and maintenance access inside wet wells or pump stations. They prevent cables from being damaged by water, mechanical stress, or interference, and simplify disconnection or replacement of equipment without severing cables. In pump stations, cable trays connect in-well components directly to control or disconnect panels, enabling safe unplugging of pumps using Meltric or similar connectors.

Installation and Support Guidelines

- Compliance with Standards: Cable trays must follow NEC Article 392 and relevant IEC standards. NEC specifies minimum conductor sizes, maximum rung spacing, and securement intervals for horizontal and vertical runs. IEC 61537 provides guidance on tray design, bend radii, and support spacing.



- **Securing Cables:** Cables should be fastened to the tray at regular intervals using listed cable ties or clamps. Non-horizontal runs require attachment to transverse members to prevent sagging or stress .
- **Segregation and Fill:** Cables of different voltages may share a tray if rated appropriately, but high-voltage cables (>600V) require separation from lower-voltage circuits . Tray fill must not exceed manufacturer or code limits to avoid overheating.
- **Mechanical Protection:** Cable trays are designed to support cables, not as walkways or ladders. They must withstand forces generated during short circuits or maintenance operations without damaging the cables .

Best Practices

- **Pre-planning:** Layout should follow straight, logical paths with minimal bends to reduce stress on cables .
- **Bend Radius Control:** Maintain minimum bending radii according to cable specifications to prevent insulation damage .
- **Grounding and Bonding:** Metal trays must be properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards.
- **Maintenance Access:** Trays should allow easy access for inspection, testing, and replacement of cables without requiring specialized tools or severing connections .
