Electrical rooms are designed for high-voltage equipment, and placing IT equipment in the same space can create electrical hazards. Codes often require clearances around electrical panels (typically at least 1.2 meters in front of panels) to allow safe maintenance . Mixing server racks with electrical infrastructure can increase the risk of accidental contact, complicate emergency access, and may violate local building or fire codes .

Cooling and Power Load

Server racks generate significant heat, and electrical rooms may not have adequate cooling for IT equipment. Overheating can lead to equipment failure or reduced lifespan . Additionally, the combined power load of servers and electrical equipment must be carefully calculated to avoid overloading circuits. Proper UPS systems, PDUs, and structured cabling are essential to safely distribute power to the rack .

Access and Security

Electrical rooms often require frequent access by electricians, while server rooms require restricted access for IT staff. Placing a rack in a shared space can create security and operational conflicts, as non-IT personnel may need to enter the server area to access electrical panels . Solutions include installing a physical barrier or wall, locking server racks, and using access control systems to separate IT equipment from electrical infrastructure .

Best Practices

- Maintain adequate clearance around both electrical panels and server racks for safety and maintenance.
- Ensure dedicated cooling for the server rack, possibly with a small air conditioning unit or airflow management.
- Use rack-mounted PDUs and UPS systems to manage power distribution safely.
- Implement restricted access and monitoring to prevent unauthorized entry.
- Consider future expansion and IT load to avoid overcrowding or overheating .

Conclusion

While it is technically possible to place a network server rack in a power supply room, it introduces safety, cooling, and access challenges. The preferred approach is to create a separate, dedicated server room or at least a physically separated area within the electrical room that meets clearance, cooling, and security requirements. Proper planning and adherence to electrical and fire codes are essential to ensure safe and reliable operation.
