Cable trays are designed to support and route electrical conductors, such as tray-rated power cables, control cables, and communication lines, in an organized and ventilated manner (NEC Article 392) . They are not intended to serve as mounting surfaces for electrical devices like power strips. Installing a power strip directly on a tray can:

- Exceed tray fill limits: Cable trays have strict fill percentages (40% for power cables, 50% for control cables) to prevent overheating and maintain airflow . Adding a power strip may obstruct airflow and increase heat buildup.
- Compromise grounding and bonding: Metallic trays can serve as an equipment grounding conductor if properly bonded, but power strips are not designed to integrate with tray grounding systems .



- Create mechanical hazards: Power strips are not rated for the vibration, weight, or environmental exposure typical in industrial cable tray installations .

Recommended Alternatives

If you need to provide multiple outlets near a cable tray:

- Use tray-mounted receptacle assemblies: These are specifically designed for mounting on or near cable trays and comply with NEC requirements.
- Install junction boxes or raceways: Mount power strips inside a properly rated enclosure or on a wall/structure adjacent to the tray.
- Maintain separation: Keep power distribution devices physically separate from data or control cables to prevent electromagnetic interference (EMI) and maintain code compliance .

While cable trays provide excellent support for cables, they are not intended for mounting power strips. Doing so can violate NEC standards, reduce safety, and increase the risk of overheating or electrical faults. The safest approach is to use NEC-compliant receptacle assemblies or enclosures mounted near the tray rather than directly on it. This ensures proper grounding, airflow, and mechanical stability while maintaining compliance with NEC Article 392 .
