A fiber optic pigtail is a short length of optical fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare fiber on the other for splicing to incoming cables in the field . Unlike patch cords, which have connectors on both ends, pigtails are designed to provide low-loss, reliable connections in optical distribution frames (ODFs), terminal boxes, or splice trays . The bare end is typically fusion or mechanically spliced to the main fiber, while the connector end plugs into active equipment or patch panels.

Circle-to-Circle Configuration

The term circle-to-circle generally refers to pigtails where both ends are terminated with circular connectors or arranged in a looped configuration for specific network layouts. This setup can be useful in:

- Redundant network loops where fibers need to connect in a circular topology.
- Testing or measurement setups where both ends interface with circular ports.

- Specialized ODF or patch panel designs requiring circular connector interfaces. This configuration maintains the precision of factory-terminated connectors while allowing flexible field splicing, ensuring low insertion loss and high return loss .

Connector Types and Fiber Modes

Common connectors for pigtails include SC, LC, ST, FC, and MU, available in UPC or APC polish types . Pigtails can be single-mode (OS1/OS2) or multimode (OM3/OM4) depending on the application . For circle-to-circle setups, the choice of connector must match the equipment or patch panel ports.
