Safety Considerations

- Each appliance connected to a ring circuit should use a fused plug to protect the flexible cord, as the circuit breaker rating is higher than the individual outlet load .
- Ring circuits are commonly rated at 30 A with 2.5 mm² cable, though longer runs or high insulation may require thicker cables .
- Installation should comply with local electrical standards, such as BS 7671 in the UK, and be performed by a qualified electrician .

Ring circuits are widely used in residential homes for general power outlets and lighting, particularly in the UK, Ireland, and other regions influenced by British wiring standards . They are less common in North America, where radial circuits dominate.
