1. Compliance with Regulations: Electrical distribution boxes must comply with the National Electrical Code (NEC, ANSI/NFPA 70) and OSHA construction standards (29 CFR 1926 Subpart K). These regulations cover installation, grounding, overcurrent protection, and safe access to energized parts. State-specific plans may impose additional requirements. 2. Installation and Location:

- Boxes should be mounted securely and protected from physical damage, moisture, and unauthorized access.
 - Temporary wiring must be designed for anticipated loads, with proper capacity for lighting, power tools, and equipment.
 - Maintain safe distances from overhead lines (typically >3m, or >4m for scaffolds) and verify underground cables before excavation.
3. Protective Measures:

- Covers must prevent accidental contact with live parts, and cables should enter/exit through insulated bushings .
 - Disconnecting means should be visible and capable of isolating both motors and controllers .
 - Only authorized/licensed electricians should remove covers or perform energized work .
4. Inspection Checklist Items:

- Verify proper grounding and bonding of the distribution box .
 - Check ELCBs, fuses, and circuit breakers for correct ratings and functionality .
 - Inspect for physical damage, corrosion, or water ingress .
 - Ensure temporary wiring connections are secure and protected from mechanical stress .
 - Confirm warning signage and labeling are present for high-voltage circuits .
5. Risk Mitigation and Training:
- Conduct site-specific risk assessments and develop Safe Work Method Statements (SWMS) for tasks near live electrical apparatus .
 - Train workers and operators on electrical hazards and safe practices, including working near live powerlines .

• Regular maintenance audits and inspections should be scheduled to identify hazards and ensure compliance .

6. Enforcement and Penalties: Non-compliance can result in fines or citations. For example, in Australia, businesses may face fines up to \$3,600 and individuals up to \$720 for failing to protect workers from electrical risks . OSHA frequently cites violations related to improper grounding, exposed live parts, and inadequate training .

Electrical distribution boxes on construction sites must be securely installed, properly grounded, and regularly inspected. Compliance with NEC, OSHA, and local regulations, combined with trained personnel, protective measures, and routine audits, ensures a safe working environment and minimizes the risk of electrical accidents .
