1. Choose the Appropriate Location

Select a sheltered, accessible location for the junction box, such as a telecom room, corridor, or outdoor wall with minimal direct exposure to sunlight and water. Ensure the mounting surface is flat and stable to support the box's weight and allow easy access for maintenance .

- Use weatherproof gaskets and mechanical seals to maintain IP65 protection against dust, rain, and UV exposure .

4. Fiber Splicing and Management

- Open the splice trays and organize fibers by type (drop, feeder, or distribution).
- Perform fusion or mechanical splicing according to standard procedures.
- Store excess fiber in the tray, ensuring no sharp bends and proper routing to SC adapters or splitters.
- If using splitters, install them in designated slots (e.g., 1:16 or 1:8 LGX PLC splitters) and secure fibers to prevent strain .

5. Termination and Adapter Installation

- Install SC simplex adapters in the front interconnect area.
- Ensure connector polarity and type (SC/APC or SC/UPC) match upstream and downstream standards.
- Label each port clearly for easy identification during troubleshooting or expansion .

6. Environmental Protection and Final Checks

- Close the box securely, ensuring all latches or screws are tightened.
- Verify that all cable entries are sealed and the enclosure maintains IP65 integrity.
- Check that fibers are neatly routed, splices are protected, and splitters are secured.
- Confirm that the box is accessible for future maintenance without compromising environmental protection .

7. Maintenance Tips

- Periodically inspect the box for water ingress, dust, or UV damage.
- Ensure splice trays remain organized and fibers are not stressed.
- Replace worn gaskets or seals to maintain IP65 protection over time . By following these steps, a 48-core fiber optic junction box can be securely installed, environmentally protected, and organized for reliable network performance.
