How Routers Connect to Fiber

Fiber optic internet typically requires an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts the fiber signal from your ISP into an Ethernet signal that your router can use . Most routers do not connect directly to the fiber cable; instead, the fiber cable plugs into the ONT, and then an Ethernet cable links the ONT to the router's WAN port. Some high-end routers also support SFP or SFP+ ports, allowing direct fiber connections for multi-gig speeds .

Router Compatibility and Ports

- **WAN Port Speed:** For fiber plans of 1 Gbps or higher, routers should have at least a 2.5 GbE WAN port. For 2+ Gbps fiber, a 10 GbE RJ45 or SFP+ port is recommended to avoid bottlenecks .
- **Wi-Fi Standards:** Wi-Fi 6, 6E, and Wi-Fi 7 routers can handle high-speed fiber connections wirelessly. Wi-Fi 7 with Multi-Link Operation (MLO) and 320 MHz channels provides the best performance for gigabit-plus fiber .

- **LAN Aggregation:** Some routers allow combining LAN ports to increase throughput, useful for wired devices requiring high bandwidth .

Recommended Setup Steps

- **Install the ONT:** Connect the fiber cable from the wall outlet to the ONT and power it on. Wait for the status lights to stabilize .
- **Connect Router to ONT:** Use an Ethernet cable from the ONT's Ethernet/LAN port to the router's WAN port. If the router supports SFP, you can use a compatible fiber module for direct connection .
- **Power On and Configure Router:** Turn on the router and follow the setup instructions to configure Wi-Fi, security, and network settings. Ensure the router firmware is up to date for optimal performance .

Choosing the Right Router

When selecting a router for fiber internet, consider:

- **Multi-gig WAN/LAN ports** for high-speed fiber plans .
- **Latest Wi-Fi standards** (Wi-Fi 6E or Wi-Fi 7) for maximum wireless throughput .
- **Coverage area and internal antenna strength** for large homes or offices .
- **Security features** like WPA3, VPN support, and malware protection .
