Fiber Distribution Box

A fiber distribution box (also called a fiber distribution hub or optical distribution box) is a larger enclosure designed for intermediate network points, such as building corridors, stairways, or outdoor community spaces. Its primary functions include:

- **Distribution:** Splits and routes fibers from the feeder cable to multiple subscriber endpoints .
- **Splicing and Organization:** Houses splice cassettes or trays to manage fiber slack, maintain bend radius, and organize pigtails .
- **Connector Management:** Provides multiple fiber connectors for easy connection to subscriber lines .
- **Environmental Protection:** Designed for indoor or outdoor use, often with IP-rated protection against dust, moisture, and temperature variations .
- **Scalability:** Supports larger fiber counts and can include splitters for FTTH networks .

- **Incoming Fiber Entry:** The feeder fiber enters the box through a designated port.
- **Splicing:** Fibers are spliced to pigtails or patch cords using fusion or mechanical splicing.
- **Slack Management:** Extra fiber length is coiled and stored in trays to prevent bending.
- **Connectorization:** Fibers are terminated with connectors (LC, SC, ST, etc.) for easy patching.
- **Distribution:** In a distribution box, fibers are routed to multiple outputs for subscriber connections . In summary, distribution box termination ensures that fiber optic networks are organized, protected, and efficiently routed from a central feeder to multiple endpoints, maintaining signal quality and network reliability.
