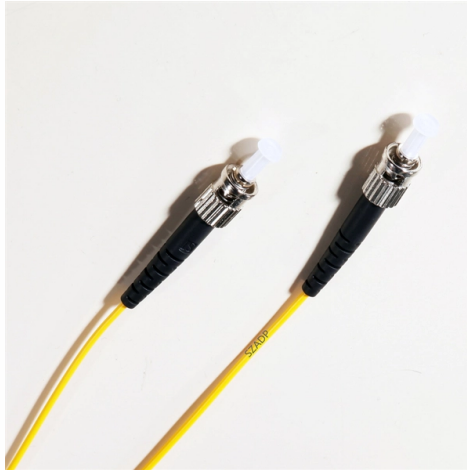


Do fireproof cable trays come with built-in partitions
