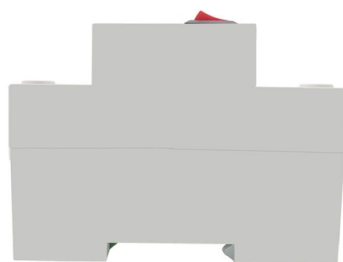


Drilling holes for wiring in the electrical distribution box of a fully furnished apartment



Overview

You can drill a few holes by putting a 3/4-inch spade bit in your electric drill, but for larger jobs, we recommend renting a heavy-duty right angle drill (\$25 per day) and equipping it with a 3/4-inch x 6-inch auger bit (\$7). Follow these tips for drilling holes for cable runs through studs or joists. Once boxes are in place, you're ready to run cable to each of them. It's rather like connecting dots with a pencil line. To prevent screws or nails from puncturing cables, drill in the middle of studs or joists whenever. Knowing whether you can drill a hole in a junction box and how to do it safely can save you time, money, and frustration, while also ensuring that your electrical system is up to code and functions correctly. Whether you're installing new outlets, lighting fixtures, or running new wiring, drilling precise and strategically. Today, you will learn how to drill holes for electrical wires. The process may seem straight-forward, but like anything in the electrical field, it's the LITTLE TRICKS that make all the difference. The golden rule is YOU ONLY WANT TO DRILL HOLES ONCE. Ever wondered why certain wire gauges fit snugly in some. Even if you've never picked up an electrical tool in your life, you can safely rough-in electrical wiring, because plastic boxes and flexible nonmetallic cable (commonly called Romex) put electrical wiring projects within the skill range of every dedicated DIYer.
