A first-floor distribution box, also called a sub-distribution board, receives electricity from the main supply or main distribution board and distributes it to various circuits such as lighting, sockets, and appliances on that floor . It ensures safe and controlled power distribution, prevents overloads, and allows for easy maintenance. Each circuit is typically protected by a circuit breaker or fuse, and leakage protection devices are installed to prevent electrical hazards .

Installation Considerations

- Placement: Install the box in a dry, accessible area with good ventilation, typically at a height of around 1.5 meters for easy access .
- Protection Devices: Include circuit breakers, fuses, and residual current devices (RCDs) for each sub-circuit .

- **Wiring:** Ensure proper grounding, correct wire gauge, and neat cable management. Sub-circuits from the first-floor distribution box connect to lamps, fans, sockets, and other electrical devices .
- **Material and Enclosure:** Indoor boxes are usually made of plastic or steel, with an IP rating suitable for indoor use. Steel is preferred for durability, while plastic is lightweight and corrosion-resistant .

Configuration in Multi-Story Buildings

In multi-story buildings, each floor can have its own distribution box connected to either a separate energy meter or a main meter on the ground floor . The first-floor box typically receives power through a main switch and main fuse, then distributes it to sub-circuits. This setup allows quick access in emergencies and ensures that each floor's load is properly managed. For larger buildings, a three-level distribution system may be used, where the first-level cabinet handles main power, the second-level cabinet manages building-level distribution, and the third-level (floor-level) box serves individual circuits .

Safety and Maintenance

- Label all circuits for easy identification.
- Perform visual inspections and multimeter tests before powering on .
- Schedule regular maintenance to ensure long-term reliability.
- Avoid overloading the box; choose a box with capacity for current needs and future expansion . A properly installed first-floor distribution box ensures efficient, safe, and organized electricity distribution, protecting both the building and its occupants while allowing for easy upgrades or repairs.
