Fiber optic connectors transmit data using light through a glass or plastic core, and the ferrule aligns the fiber to minimize signal loss. While ceramic ferrules are common, metal ferrules—made from stainless steel, titanium, copper, or ARCAP—are used in applications requiring higher mechanical strength, thermal stability, or resistance to harsh environments. Metal connectors are available for standard types such as ST, SC, FC, LC, and F-SMA.

- **Ferrule Material:** Metal ferrules provide robust alignment and protection for the fiber, especially in high-vibration or high-temperature environments. Stainless steel ferrules, for example, can operate continuously up to 250°C and in vacuum conditions down to 10^{-10} Torr.

- Precision: Metal ferrules maintain tight tolerances for fiber alignment, ensuring low insertion loss and minimal back reflection, which is critical for high-precision laser or analog signal applications .
- Compatibility: Metal ferrules can be used with multimode or single-mode fibers, and bore diameters can range from tens of micrometers up to over 1 mm, depending on the fiber type and application .
