Dedicated Electrical Panel: The room should be served by a dedicated electrical panel with spare circuits to accommodate future expansion. Typically, three 30A spare circuits are recommended for new installations to support additional racks or equipment (). **Circuit Placement:** Circuits should be distributed to serve core and distribution racks, patch panels, and ancillary equipment. Outlets should be mounted 1 inch below ladder trays or at 85 inches above finished floor, whichever is lower, to ensure easy access while maintaining cable management standards (). **Redundancy and Safety:** Consider redundant circuits for critical equipment to prevent downtime. All wiring must comply with local electrical codes, TIA/EIA-568 standards, and grounding requirements per ANSI/TIA/EIA 607-B ().

Rack Adjacency: Core and distribution racks should be adjacent to minimize horizontal cabling lengths and simplify power distribution (). **Service Loops:** Provide service loops for all horizontal cables not exceeding 10 feet to allow for maintenance and reconfiguration (). **Wall and Mounting Considerations:** Install 3/4" fire-rated plywood on walls, painted with fire-retardant paint, to support outlet mounting and equipment brackets (). **Ladder Trays and Conduits:** Use dedicated ladder trays for power and fiber cabling, ensuring separation of high-voltage and low-voltage lines to reduce interference and maintain safety ().
