Fiber optic sensors operate by detecting changes in light properties—such as intensity, phase, wavelength, or polarization—caused by external physical parameters like temperature, strain, pressure, or chemical composition . Optical fibers act as waveguides, transmitting light from the sensing region to a detector, allowing remote and precise measurements. Two main sensing schemes exist:

- Point Sensing: Uses discrete sensors like fiber Bragg gratings (FBG) or interferometers to measure localized changes with high precision, achieving sub-micron deformation or 0.1°C temperature resolution .
- Distributed Sensing: Exploits scattering phenomena—Rayleigh, Brillouin, and Raman scattering—to measure parameters continuously along the fiber length, enabling monitoring over kilometers .

Imaging Applications

Fiber optic sensing is increasingly applied in imaging and visualization across medical, industrial, and structural domains:

- **Medical Imaging:** In radiation therapy, scintillating fiber dosimeters and fiber Bragg grating sensors provide real-time, high-resolution imaging of radiation dose distribution and tissue response, supporting adaptive radiotherapy and in vivo monitoring . Raman and fluorescence spectroscopy integrated with fibers allow biochemical imaging of tissues for tumor characterization.
 - **Structural and Industrial Monitoring:** Distributed fiber optic sensing (DFOS) transforms existing optical fibers into continuous sensor arrays, capable of imaging strain, temperature, and vibrations along pipelines, bridges, or aerospace structures . NASA's Fiber Optic Sensing System (FOSS) demonstrates high-resolution imaging of structural deformation and operational loads in aircraft and spacecraft .
 - **Environmental and Infrastructure Imaging:** DFOS can detect anomalies, monitor liquid levels, and visualize stress distribution in real time, providing a continuous “optical image” of the monitored system .
- Advantages of Fiber Optic Imaging
- **High spatial resolution:** Sub-millimeter or sub-micron precision in point sensing and continuous imaging in distributed systems .
 - **Remote and flexible deployment:** Fibers can be integrated into narrow or confined spaces, catheters, or long infrastructures .
 - **Electromagnetic immunity and safety:** Ideal for hazardous environments where electrical sensors are unsuitable .
 - **Multiplexing capability:** Multiple sensors can be monitored along a single fiber using wavelength or time-domain techniques .
