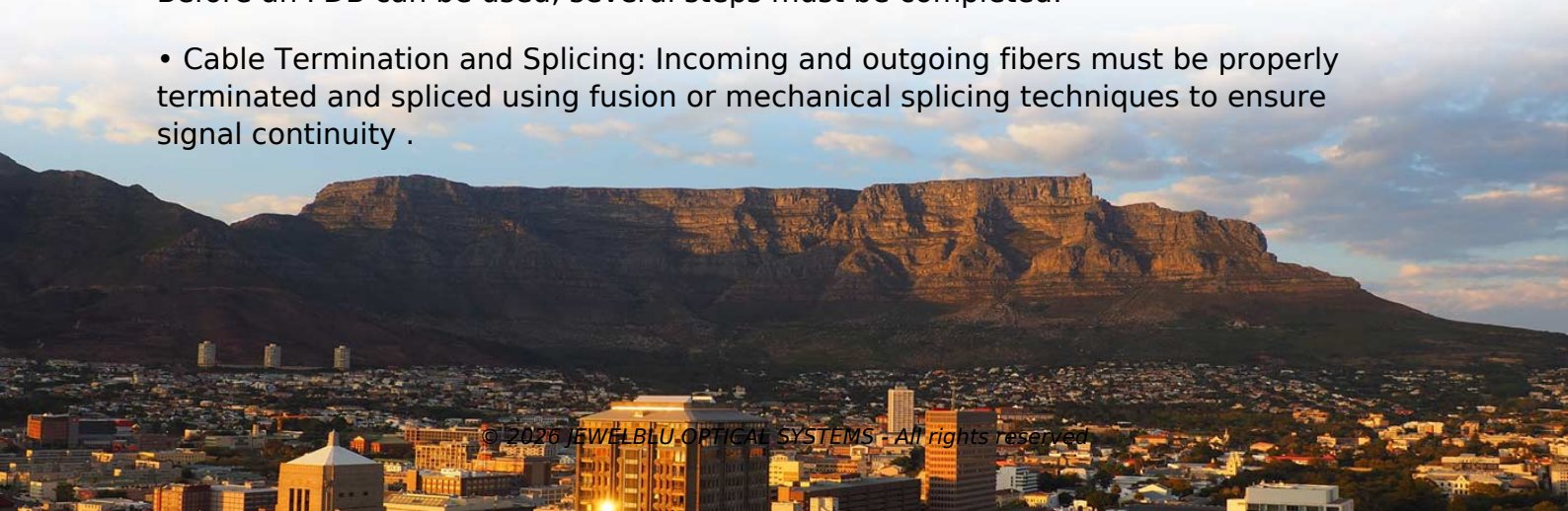

 - **Fiber Management:** Slack storage, bend-radius protection, and organized routing within splice trays are necessary to prevent damage and maintain optical performance .
 - **Environmental Protection:** Outdoor boxes require appropriate IP ratings and durable materials to withstand dust, moisture, and UV exposure .
- Integration into Network Architecture

Distribution boxes are intermediate points in fiber networks, connecting feeder cables to subscriber branches or other network components . Their effectiveness depends on proper placement, network topology, and compatibility with other equipment. Simply installing a box without splicing, terminating, or connecting fibers will not enable data transmission.
