- **Wall-Mounted Boxes:** Designed for indoor use in homes, offices, or data centers, these boxes are compact and can accommodate various fiber connectors, making them ideal for small to medium installations .
- **Rack-Mounted Boxes:** Installed on standard 19-inch racks, these are suited for high-density environments like data centers, supporting a large number of fiber connections .
- **Floor-Mounted Boxes:** Used in large data centers or high-density setups where space is limited, providing robust capacity for multiple fibers .



- **Dome-Type Boxes:** Outdoor boxes designed to withstand harsh environmental conditions such as moisture, dust, and temperature extremes, often used in street cabinets or junction boxes .

Types by Fiber Configuration

- **Straight-Through Terminal Boxes:** Feature a single external hole for the incoming fiber line, suitable for simple point-to-point connections .
- **Branched-Type Terminal Boxes:** Have multiple entry points for incoming fibers, allowing complex distribution setups. They can be configured as 2-in 8-out, 4-in 12-out, 4-in 24-out, etc., depending on network requirements .

Material and Design Variations

- **Plastic or Metal Shells:** Boxes can be made from durable plastic or metal, providing protection against physical damage and environmental factors .
- **Indoor vs. Outdoor:** Indoor boxes are compact and suitable for MDUs or MTUs, while outdoor boxes are weatherproof, dustproof, and often lockable for security .
- **Single-Mode vs. Multi-Mode Support:** Single-mode boxes are used for long-distance transmission with a 9 μm core, while multi-mode boxes support short-distance, high-bandwidth applications with 50 μm or 62.5 μm cores .

- **FTB Max:** Supports up to 168 fibers in a compact design, suitable for mass deployment in residential units .
- **FTB Speed and FTB Connect:** Offer modularity and flexibility for multi-dwelling units, accommodating splitters, patch, and splice options .
