1. Rotary Armored Cable Cutter A rotary cutter is specifically designed for armored cables, featuring a sharp circular blade that scores the armor as it rotates around the cable. This method allows controlled removal of steel or aluminum layers without damaging the inner fibers. Proper alignment and steady pressure are essential to avoid micro-cracks in the glass fibers, which can degrade signal quality . 2. Grinding and Polishing for Fiber Preparation After removing the armor, the exposed fiber ends often require grinding or polishing to ensure optimal optical performance. Polishing films and pads are used in stages:

- Fine-grade films (1–3 μm) for rough shaping and debris removal
- Ultra-fine films (0.3–1 μm) for final polishing to minimize signal loss

- Polishing pads or sticks provide consistent pressure and can be used manually or with automated systems
 - Lubricants or compounds may be applied to reduce friction and prevent scratches .
4. Kevlar and Steel-Specific Techniques Armored cables often include Kevlar or steel layers. Kevlar requires careful handling with specialized shears or cutters, while steel armor may benefit from cold cutting or grinding to extend tool life and reduce heat buildup, which can damage fibers .

Safety and Best Practices

- Always wear protective eyewear and gloves when grinding or cutting armored cables to prevent injury from metal shards or fiber splinters .
- Maintain perpendicular pressure when cutting or grinding to avoid burrs and uneven edges.
- Remove debris carefully to prevent contamination of the fiber end.
- Use tension control and angle precision to minimize optical loss; even a 2° misalignment can cause measurable signal degradation .
- Avoid reusing blades across different armor types to prevent cross-contamination and tool wear .
