Grounding a residential distribution box involves creating a low-resistance path for fault currents to safely dissipate into the earth. This protects both people and equipment from electrical shocks, surges, and fire hazards. The grounding system typically includes a grounding electrode (ground rod), a grounding electrode conductor, and proper bonding to metallic parts of the electrical system and building structure .

Grounding Conductor and Connections

- **Conductor Size:** In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) copper wire is commonly used for grounding residential panels, while other markets may require a 6 mm² conductor .
- **Connection Points:** Attach the grounding conductor from the distribution box's threaded stud to the mounting plate, and then from the mounting plate to the main grounding electrode or central grounding point .
- **Resistance Requirement:** The total ground resistance should be less than 25 ohms, with some systems aiming for
