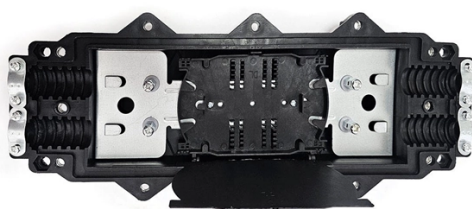


How long should the network patch panel be
