

How to connect a mobile fiber optic pigtail

Step 4: Protect the Splice

After splicing, slide a heat-shrink sleeve over the joint and apply heat to secure it. This protects the splice from mechanical stress and environmental factors .

Step 5: Connect to Equipment

Plug the factory-terminated connector end of the pigtail into the desired device, patch panel, or optical distribution frame (ODF). Ensure the connector is clean and free of dust to prevent signal loss .

Step 6: Test the Connection

Use an OTDR or optical power meter to verify the splice quality and overall link performance. Check for low attenuation and minimal return loss to confirm a successful installation .

- Always use pre-tested, high-quality pigtails to reduce errors.
- Keep fibers clean and handle them carefully to avoid scratches or contamination.
- Avoid bending fibers sharply; maintain proper bend radius.
