A pigtail cable is a short length of wire or optical fiber with a factory-installed connector on one end and a bare or stripped end on the other. In fiber optics, the bare end is designed to be fusion-spliced or mechanically spliced to a trunk fiber, while in electrical systems, the bare end is spliced to circuit wiring using wire nuts or push-in connectors. Types of Pigtails

- Splice the Fiber: Align the bare end of the pigtail with the incoming fiber and perform a fusion splice to create a continuous optical path.

- Test the Connection: Verify low insertion loss and high return loss to ensure signal integrity.

- Terminate in Patch Panels: The connector end plugs into switches, routers, or patch panels for easy integration .
