- Firmly push the lever of the identified breaker from the “ON” position to the “OFF” position.
- You should hear a click, and the power to that circuit will be cut . 5. Confirm the Circuit is Off
- Check that the appliance or light connected to the circuit is no longer powered.
- This ensures you have tripped the correct breaker . 6. Additional Tips
- Stand to the side of the panel when flipping the breaker to avoid sparks.
- Avoid forcing switches or tampering with breakers, as this can cause damage or electrocution .
- If unsure, consult a licensed electrician for assistance.
