

How to wind the fiber optic cable onto the cable reel

Winding Procedure

- **Mount the Reel:** Place the empty reel on a stable cable reel stand or jack that allows it to rotate freely. This prevents twisting and ensures smooth winding.
- **Guide the Cable:** Use a passive cable guide or manually guide the cable evenly across the drum. Avoid piling the cable on one side, which can cause uneven tension and kinks.
- **Maintain Tension:** Keep a slight, consistent tension while winding. Too much tension can stretch or damage the fiber, while too little can result in loose loops that tangle during deployment.

- Layering: Wind the cable in neat, level layers, ensuring each loop lies flat against the previous one. Avoid crossing loops or sharp bends, which can create micro-cracks or signal loss .
- Follow the Natural Lay: Pay attention to the cable's natural twist and lay. Winding against it can introduce torsional stress, leading to kinks or wavy fiber .
- Use Figure-8 for Long Lengths: If handling long cable lengths before final installation, consider laying the cable in a figure-8 pattern to cancel twists before winding onto the reel .

Safety and Precautions

- Do not exceed the maximum pulling force specified by the manufacturer .
- Avoid crushing or sharp bends; maintain the minimum bend radius at all times .
- Inspect the reel and cable periodically during winding to ensure no damage occurs .
- Store the wound reel properly, keeping it in a dry, temperature-controlled environment to prevent environmental damage . By following these steps, you can ensure that fiber optic cable is wound safely, maintains its integrity, and is ready for deployment without signal degradation or physical damage.
