1. Turn Off Power Before starting, switch off the circuit at the main breaker to prevent electric shock. Verify the power is off using a voltage tester. 2. Prepare the Wires Strip about 1/2 inch (12-15 mm) of insulation from the ends of each wire using a wire stripper. For a two-core cable, you typically have a live (brown or red) and a neutral (blue or black) wire . 3. Identify Terminals Most terminal boxes have a two-way connector block for two-core cables. Assign one terminal for the live wire and the other for the neutral wire. If the box has a four-way block, only two terminals are used for a two-core cable . 4. Connect the Wires Insert the stripped end of the live wire into the designated terminal and tighten the screw securely. Repeat for the neutral wire. Ensure no bare wire is exposed outside the terminal block . 5. Organize the Wires Neatly arrange the wires inside the box to prevent overcrowding. Avoid sharp bends and ensure wires are not pinched when closing the box . 6. Grounding (if applicable) If the terminal box or cable includes a ground wire (bare or green/yellow), connect it to the grounding terminal or metal box as required by local electrical codes. 7. Close the Box Once all connections are secure and properly insulated, close the terminal box cover. Ensure the cover fits snugly and no wires are trapped. 8. Test the Circuit Turn the power back on and test the connected devices to ensure proper operation. Double-check that all connections are stable and there are no sparks or unusual heat.

Safety Tips

- Always use insulated tools and wear protective gloves and goggles.
- Use appropriately rated terminal blocks for the wire gauge.
- Avoid over-tightening screws, which can damage the wire.
- If unsure about any step, consult a licensed electrician . By following these steps, you can safely wire a two-core indoor terminal box, ensuring reliable electrical connections and compliance with safety standards.
