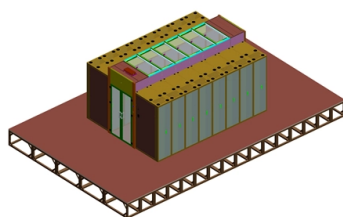

Improper grounding in a distribution box can lead to several hazards:

- **Electric shock risk:** Fault currents may not be safely channeled to earth, increasing the potential difference between conductive parts and the ground, endangering personnel .
- **Equipment damage:** Lightning strikes, transient overvoltages, or fault currents can damage sensitive equipment if grounding is inadequate .
- **System instability:** Voltage levels may fluctuate, causing protective devices like circuit breakers and relays to malfunction .
- **Fault detection issues:** Incorrect grounding can obscure fault currents, making it difficult to isolate and clear faults efficiently .

Common Causes

- Ground wires not connected to the dedicated ground bar or mounting plate .

- Use of substandard materials such as low-quality copper or improperly sized conductors .
- Exceeding the maximum allowable ground resistance (typically
