For residential and indoor settings, the ideal height for mounting a distribution box is generally between 1.3 meters and 1.8 meters (4.3-6 ft) from the floor. This range allows easy access for operation, inspection, and maintenance without excessive bending or stretching, while keeping the box out of reach of small children. For elderly or disabled individuals, a slightly lower height around 1.3 meters (4.3 ft) is suggested to improve accessibility. The National Electrical Code (NEC) specifies that panelboards should not exceed 6 ft 7 in (2 meters) above the floor, with a dedicated workspace extending up to 6 ft (1.8 meters) for safe operation.

Safety and Accessibility Considerations

- Avoid wet or hazardous areas: Install the box away from sinks, bathrooms, or areas prone to water exposure to prevent electrical hazards.
- Provide adequate clearance: Ensure sufficient space around the box for ventilation, inspection, and future maintenance.

- Firm mounting: Secure the box to a stable wall surface to prevent movement or accidental damage .
 - Labeling and organization: Clearly label circuits and maintain neat wiring to facilitate safe operation and troubleshooting .
- Compliance with Standards
- NEC (National Electrical Code): Requires proper grounding, bonding, and workspace clearance for panelboards and subpanels .
 - IEC 61439 / BS 7671: Recommend residential distribution boards be installed between 1 m and 1.8 m, with special consideration for accessibility and safety .
 - UL/CE-certified components: Use certified parts to ensure compliance and long-term reliability .
- Practical Tips
- Mount the box in a hallway, utility room, or other dry, accessible location.
 - Ensure the top of the panelboard does not exceed 6.5 ft (2 meters) to maintain safe working space .
 - Leave room for future upgrades or maintenance by avoiding tight corners or obstructed areas . By following these guidelines, the distribution box will be safe, accessible, and compliant with electrical codes, providing reliable operation for residential or commercial indoor installations.
