1. Physical Containment Verification

- Confirm that cold aisle partitions are self-supporting and do not compromise structural integrity of racks or frames .

 - Verify that rack heights and aisle widths are uniform if using modular containment systems attached to racks .
 - Confirm that power distribution units and cabling do not obstruct airflow and are properly routed through vertical or horizontal bridges .
- ### 4. Safety and Operational Checks
- Ensure service clearances are maintained for maintenance and emergency access .
 - Assess potential heat stress risks for personnel working near hot aisles and provide appropriate safety measures .
 - Confirm that environmental monitoring systems (temperature, humidity) are operational and integrated with the data center management system .
- ### 5. Energy Efficiency and Performance Validation
- Evaluate cooling energy reduction and PUE improvements post-installation .
 - Check that containment supports economizer optimization and higher compute densities without compromising airflow .
 - Document any deviations from design specifications and recommend corrective actions to maintain optimal thermal management.
- ### Recommended Inspection Procedure
- Conduct a pre-installation review of the cold aisle layout and containment design.
 - Perform a physical inspection of partitions, doors, ceiling panels, and blanking panels.
 - Measure airflow, temperature, and pressure at multiple points along the aisle.
 - Verify rack and equipment placement, including cabling and power distribution.
 - Record findings, identify issues, and schedule corrective actions if necessary.

- Conduct a final validation after adjustments to ensure containment integrity and cooling efficiency.
