

Install a canopy on the distribution box



Overview

Insert non-power feed canopy over the stem, and secure the canopy in place by threading the cable coupler and suspension cable onto the protruding stem. They may also be used on other manufacturers brand of quick connect (consult factory for compatibility). This canopy mounts to a standard 4" junction box, or directly to a surface (use conduit. Refer to illustration on right to prepare junction box for attachment to canopy kit. Make sure attachment screws are set onto right position and threaded stem is also in place. Install 1/4"-20 anchor onto ceiling. Fasten threaded stem making sure that the bottom protrudes approximately 3/4" from. 1718 W. Fullerton Chicago, IL 60614 Ph: 773.
