A pigtail is a short length of cable with a factory-terminated connector on one end and a bare fiber or wire on the other. Bundled pigtails allow multiple fibers or wires to be spliced or connected efficiently in high-density environments such as ODFs, splice trays, or junction boxes . Tools and Materials Needed
