Parts Box (or Distribution Box in some contexts): A parts box is generally a smaller, simpler enclosure used for local wiring, terminal connections, or equipment-side power distribution. It may contain basic protective devices like small breakers or fuses, but often it is just an empty enclosure for organizing cables or connecting equipment. Parts boxes are commonly used for temporary setups, construction sites, or near specific machines where full circuit protection is not required .
