

Low-voltage busbar power outage



Overview

If the busbar protection fails to trip when an external fault occurs or if it falsely trips while in use, the power system could become unstable. A total power outage will result from this. Causes of Busbar Voltage Loss in Substations Equipment Failure: A major cause of busbar voltage loss is equipment malfunction, including failures of circuit. Busbars in power systems are the location where transmission lines, generation sources, and distribution loads converge. Because of this convergence, short circuits located on or near the busbar tend to have very high magnitude currents. Policy regarding fault clearance times required from busbar protection varies from utility to utility. This standard defines the design verification, test requirements, and thermal performance of the assemblies.
