- Repeat for the second side truss. Triangles are key because they prevent deformation and distribute weight evenly .

Step 4: Assemble the Bridge Frame

- Attach the side trusses to the base using glue, ensuring alignment and symmetry .
- Add cross supports diagonally between the top and bottom beams to strengthen the frame .
- Clamp or press firmly and allow the glue to dry completely before testing .

Step 5: Test and Reinforce

- Gradually add weight to test the bridge's strength.
- Reinforce weak points with additional sticks or diagonal supports if necessary .
- Avoid overloading beyond the bridge's design capacity to prevent breakage.

Tips for Success

- Use uniform, flat sticks to avoid weak spots .
- Keep triangles consistent in size and spacing for maximum strength .
- Patience is key: allow glue to dry fully before moving to the next step .
- Creativity is encouraged: you can experiment with different truss patterns or decorative elements . By following these steps, you can create a sturdy, visually appealing bridge frame that demonstrates basic engineering principles and can support significant weight relative to its size.
