- **Overfilling:** Avoid exceeding the tray's fill capacity, as this can reduce effective clearance and lead to overheating or mechanical stress .
- **Maintenance Access:** Ensure that the minimum height allows personnel to safely pull, tie, or inspect cables without obstruction.
- **Environmental Factors:** Consider corrosive environments or high moisture areas, which may require composite or FRP trays that could affect installation height .
