

Opening holes in cable tray troughs



Overview

The correct drill size depends on the hardware supplied with the cable tray. After drilling, remove burrs. Mark the position of the support system fixing points. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when the cable tray is intended for instrumentation and control applications that require. B-Line series Cable Tray Design Considerations

For ladder or ventilated trough trays, the diameter of all cables 4/0 and larger must be added together, and the total must not exceed the inside width of the cable tray.

CABLE TRAY

Do not allow the cables to drop in the cable tray as this may damage the cable and/or the cable tray. If cable connections will not be made immediately, the pulling eye or basket grip should be removed
