Optical modules, such as SFP, SFP+, QSFP, or QSFP-DD transceivers, are hot-pluggable network devices that convert electrical signals from switches, routers, or servers into optical signals for fiber transmission, and vice versa. They plug into a dedicated SFP or optical port on the device, which provides both the electrical interface and the necessary power to operate the module. The port itself is a receptacle or cage on the front panel of the device, designed to accept the module securely.

Power and Signal Handling

The optical module does not require a separate power port. Instead, the SFP or optical port supplies 3.3V power, high-speed transmit/receive lanes, and a management channel for diagnostics and module identification. The module then performs the electrical-to-optical conversion internally, allowing the device to communicate over fiber or copper cabling. This design enables hot-swapping, so modules can be replaced or upgraded without shutting down the system.

Optical Interface

Once the module is inserted into the port, the fiber optic cable connects to the module's optical interface, not directly to the device port . This means the optical port on the device is the interface for the module, while the module itself provides the optical connection to the external network.
