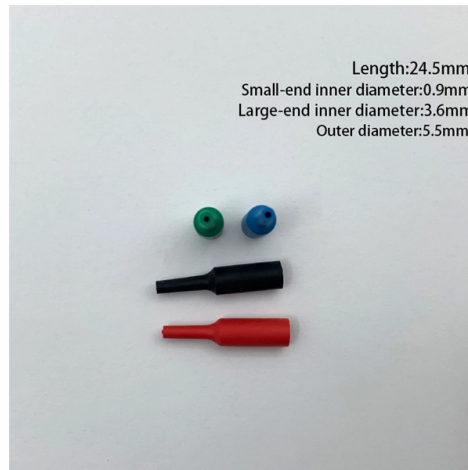

Distribution boxes are governed by standards such as the National Electrical Code (NEC) and International Electrotechnical Commission (IEC) guidelines. Key requirements include:

Environmental Protection (IP Ratings)

- **Dust Protection:** IP5X indicates dust-resistant, while IP6X is dust-tight, essential for heavy industrial or dusty environments .
 - **Water Protection:** IPX7 certification ensures the box can withstand immersion in water for 30 minutes without leakage .
 - **Material Selection:** Use corrosion-resistant materials like 316 stainless steel with protective coatings in harsh environments, such as coastal or industrial sites .
- #### Installation and Mounting Requirements

Proper installation ensures safety and operational reliability:

- **Site Selection:** Install in dry, well-ventilated areas close to the power source to reduce voltage drop and overheating .
- **Mounting Height:** Typically 1.5–1.8 meters above the ground for easy access and inspection .
- **Fixing Method:** Use secure brackets or screws to prevent movement due to vibration or impact .
- **Wiring Specifications:** Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas matching load requirements; ensure proper labeling and no exposed conductors .

Maintenance and Safety Practices

- **Regular Inspection:** Check for overheating, corrosion, or loose connections to prevent failures .
- **Arc Flash and PPE:** Conduct hazard analysis to determine required personal protective equipment during maintenance .
- **Sealing and Protection:** Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are properly sealed to maintain IP rating and prevent ingress of dust or water . By adhering to these standards, distribution boxes provide safe, reliable, and compliant electrical distribution, protecting both personnel and equipment from electrical and environmental hazards.
