Relay protection devices maintain event logs and fault records to capture operational changes and abnormal conditions in the power system. Event logs, sometimes called Operational Indication Buffers, continuously record status changes of monitored items with high time resolution, often down to 1 millisecond. These logs are typically stored in a cyclic buffer, meaning older events are overwritten as new events occur, and the memory is usually battery-backed to preserve data during power loss (SIPROTEC relays). Fault records, also known as disturbance recordings, capture detailed electrical parameters during abnormal events, including voltage, current, frequency, active and reactive power, and the timing of relay operations. These records are essential for analyzing the cause of faults and verifying relay performance.

Types of Information Captured

Relay logs can include:

- Event timestamps and status changes (e.g., breaker trips, alarms)

- Electrical measurements: voltage, current, frequency, active/reactive power
- Relay operation details: trip signals, logic conditions, and device function numbers
- Disturbance recordings: waveform data during faults for post-event analysis Each logged item may have a short text for front-panel display and a long text for software viewing, aiding in identification and troubleshooting .

Accessing and Transferring Logs

- Front-panel access: Many relays allow viewing the event log directly via the device menu (e.g., Annunciation → Event Log in SIPROTEC relays) .
- Software tools: Logs can be transferred to a PC using manufacturer-specific software (e.g., DIGSI for SIPROTEC, SFT2841 for SEPAM relays) .
- Data export: Logs can be exported in formats suitable for analysis, including CSV or proprietary formats, which include both event and disturbance data.
- Mapping monitored items: In configuration software, each monitored item can be mapped to the event log to record incoming, outgoing, or both edges of status changes .

Importance in Power System Protection

Relay logs are critical for:

- Fault analysis: Determining the cause and location of faults
- System reliability: Ensuring correct relay operation and coordination
- Maintenance planning: Identifying abnormal trends or repeated events
- Regulatory compliance: Providing documented evidence of protection system performance By reviewing these logs, engineers can verify that relays operate reliably, selectively, and promptly, isolating only the faulty section while maintaining system stability .
