The distribution board should be installed in a dry, well-ventilated, and accessible location, typically at a height of 1.5 to 1.8 meters above the ground for ease of operation and inspection . Avoid humid, corrosive, or flammable environments unless using specialized explosion-proof enclosures . The board must be firmly fixed using appropriate mounting brackets or screws to prevent movement or tilting due to vibration or accidental impact . Ensure adequate clearance around the board for maintenance access .

Enclosure and Material

- Ensure all cable inlets and cover joints are properly sealed to prevent dust or moisture ingress .

Protective Devices

A distribution board must include essential safety devices:

- Miniature Circuit Breakers (MCBs) to protect individual circuits from overcurrent and short circuits .
- Residual Current Devices (RCDs/RCBOs) to prevent electric shocks and leakage currents .
- Fuses for additional overcurrent protection where applicable .
- Surge Protective Devices (SPDs) to guard against voltage spikes and lightning surges .
- Proper grounding of the metal enclosure, electrical installation board, and connected appliances is mandatory .
- Protective neutral connections should be reliably established through terminal boards .

Compliance and Standards

Follow local electrical codes (e.g., NEC, IEC) and use UL/CE-certified components . For international compliance, adhere to standards such as IEC 61439 for construction and performance, IEC 60947-2 for circuit breakers, and IEC 61643-11 for surge protection devices . Proper documentation, labeling, and as-built drawings are recommended for future inspections and maintenance .

Testing and Maintenance

Before powering on, perform visual inspections and multimeter tests to verify correct wiring and functionality . Schedule regular maintenance and inspections to ensure long-term reliability, and consider modular designs for easier future upgrades .
