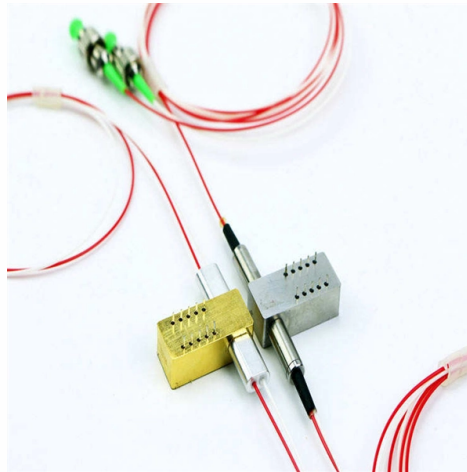

**Structural Integrity and Roof Compatibility:** Cable trays must be supported without compromising the roof. **Material Selection:** Cable trays can be made from steel, aluminum, stainless steel, or fiberglass-reinforced plastic (FRP). Material choice depends on environmental conditions:

- **Aluminum:** Lightweight, corrosion-resistant.
  - **Stainless Steel (316L):** High corrosion resistance, suitable for harsh environments.
  - **FRP:** Non-conductive, corrosion-resistant, ideal for chemical or wet environments ( ).
- Tray Types:** Selection depends on cable type and application:
- **Ladder Tray:** Open design, excellent ventilation, ideal for power cables.
  - **Ventilated Trough:** Solid bottom with ventilation holes, suitable for instrumentation cables.
  - **Solid-Bottom Tray:** Provides extra protection for sensitive cables ( ).

#### Installation Steps

- **Planning and Layout:** Review approved shop drawings, mark tray routes, and ensure no clashes with HVAC, plumbing, or other services ( ).
- **Support Installation:** Drill holes for anchors, install threaded rods or non-penetrative supports, and attach Unistrut channels or brackets. Ensure supports are level and properly spaced ( ).
- **Tray Placement:** Position trays on supports, connect sections with splice plates, and ensure smooth interior surfaces to prevent cable damage ( ).
- **Managing Bends and Risers:** Use factory-made bends or T-pieces to maintain smooth cable routing. Protect cut edges with paint or bushings ( ).
- **Thermal Expansion:** Install expansion joints or splice plates to allow metal trays to expand and contract without stress ( ).
- **Earthing and Bonding:** Ensure all metal trays are properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards ( ).
- **Final Inspection:** Check alignment, fasteners, and cable fill. Ensure trays are not overfilled (40–50% of capacity) to allow heat dissipation ( ).

#### Safety and Maintenance

- **Maintain clear access** for future maintenance.
- **Inspect supports, fasteners, and trays regularly** for corrosion, wear, or misalignment ( ).
- **Use non-penetrative supports** to reduce trip hazards and protect roof membranes ( ).

- Ensure compliance with NEC Article 392 and local electrical codes ( ).

#### Best Practices

- Avoid placing trays directly on the roof surface; elevate them to prevent water pooling and damage ( ).
- Use corrosion-resistant materials in coastal or humid environments.
- Plan for future cable additions by leaving adequate spacing and support capacity.
- Label trays and cables for easy identification and maintenance ( ). By following these guidelines, rooftop cable tray systems can be installed safely, efficiently, and in compliance with electrical and structural standards, ensuring long-term reliability and protection for both cables and roof infrastructure.
