- **Distribution:** FDFs act as intermediate nodes, distributing fibers from feeder cables to multiple directions toward subscriber access points .
- **Protection:** Enclosures protect fibers from physical damage, dust, moisture, and environmental stress. Outdoor models often meet IP65 standards for durability .
- **Organization:** They provide structured storage for excess fiber, maintain bend radius, and facilitate labeling for easy identification and maintenance .

Installation and Deployment

- **Terminal Boxes:** Typically installed indoors at the customer end, in small distribution nodes, or within building-level cabinets. They are compact and designed for near-user deployment .
- **Fiber Distribution Frames:** Installed in wiring or equipment rooms, data centers, or central offices. Rack-mounted FDFs are compatible with standard 19-inch cabinets, while wall-mounted frames suit smaller installations .
- **Outdoor Distribution Boxes:** Can be mounted on poles, walls, or inside protective cabinets, suitable for FTTH/FTTB networks .

Considerations for Selection

- **Fiber Core Capacity:** Choose a frame or box that supports current and future fiber counts to avoid wasted capacity .
- **Environmental Conditions:** Outdoor enclosures require dustproof, waterproof, and UV-resistant materials; indoor units may prioritize compactness and fire safety .
- **Access Frequency:** Terminal boxes are accessed occasionally for new connections, while FDFs may require frequent patching and testing .
- **Cable Compatibility:** Ensure compatibility with loose tube, tight buffer, ribbon, or drop cables, and verify entry port sizes and sealing methods .
