Load distribution and stress relief: Certain clamps, such as suspension or tension clamps, absorb and evenly distribute mechanical loads along the cable. This is especially important in aerial installations, where wind, ice, or temperature changes can create tension that might otherwise damage the fiber .

Routing and organization: Clamps facilitate proper cable management by guiding and organizing fiber optic lines. They help maintain spacing between fibers, prevent tangling, and allow for easier identification and maintenance, improving installation efficiency and network reliability .
