- Locate the Grounding Point Open the distribution box and identify the PE bar or earth link, which is the designated terminal for grounding wires . In some setups, the metallic body of the distribution box is also connected to the earth link for additional safety .
- Prepare the Ground Wire Use a yellow-green insulated copper wire with a cross-sectional area that meets local electrical codes (commonly 6 mm² or 10 AWG in the US) . Strip the insulation for a short length to expose the copper core.
- Connect the Wire Insert the stripped end of the ground wire into the PE bar or earth link terminal. Tighten the screw securely with a screwdriver to ensure a firm connection. If grounding multiple components, you can use crimp connectors or twist-on connectors to join wires before attaching them to the PE bar .



- **Ground Electrical Components** Any metallic components or devices within the distribution box that require grounding should also be connected to the PE bar using copper wires. This ensures all parts are safely earthed .
- **Verify and Label** Ensure all connections are tight and free from looseness. Clearly label the ground connections for future inspection and maintenance. Confirm that the grounding system complies with local regulations and achieves a low-resistance path, typically below 0.1 ohm for industrial setups .

Safety Precautions

- Always turn off the main power supply before working inside the distribution box.
- Use insulated tools to prevent accidental shocks.
- Ensure the grounding wire is continuous and not damaged.
- If unsure, consult a qualified electrician to verify compliance with local electrical codes . By following these steps, the socket ground wire will be properly connected to the distribution box, ensuring safe operation of electrical equipment and protection against electrical hazards.
