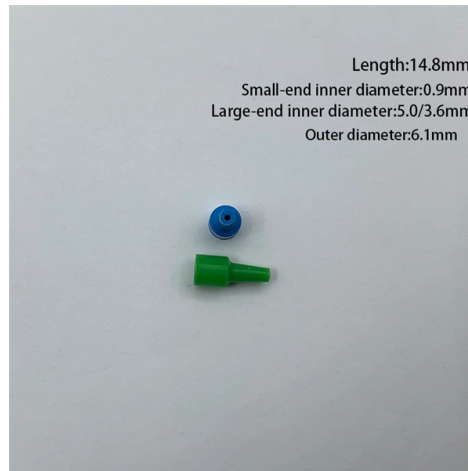

- Accessibility: Choose trays that allow easy addition or removal of cables.
- Grounding: Use trays with grounding studs or bonding options to maintain electrical safety .
- Expansion: Plan for future growth with reserved capacity and modular components .
