Avoid sharp bends or excessive pulling force, as fiber strands are delicate and can degrade signal quality . For indoor installations, use fire-resistant indoor-rated cables to meet safety regulations .

Termination and Connection

Terminate the fiber cable using a fiber optic termination kit or pre-terminated connectors. Common connector types include SC, LC, or ST . Insert the connector into the wall-mounted outlet, which serves as the central point for connecting indoor devices. Use fiber patch cords to link the outlet to routers, ONTs, or other network equipment .

Testing and Optimization

After installation, test the fiber connection using a fiber optic power meter or visual fault locator to ensure proper signal transmission . Troubleshoot any issues such as poor connections or signal loss. Once verified, configure your network devices and optimize router placement for maximum performance .

Best Practices

- Leave extra conduit space (25–40%) for future expansion .
- Maintain proper bend radius and avoid kinks in the fiber.
- Use armored or reinforced cables if the installation is exposed to potential physical stress .
