Purpose of Warning Signs
Warning signs on electrical distribution boxes serve to alert personnel to potential hazards, prevent accidental contact with live components, and guide safe operation and maintenance. Proper signage reduces the risk of electrical shock, burns, arc flash, and electrocution while facilitating emergency response and maintenance efficiency .

Common Types of Warning Signs

- **Danger: High Voltage** – Indicates the presence of high voltage that can cause severe injury or death; typically found on substations, transformer enclosures, and high-voltage panels .
- **Electrical Shock Hazard** – Warns of exposed live parts; used near breaker rooms, industrial machinery, and control panels .
- **Arc Flash Hazard** – Highlights equipment capable of releasing dangerous energy; labels often specify incident energy levels and required PPE such as face shields, gloves, and protective clothing .

- Authorized Personnel Only – Restricts access to trained personnel to prevent unqualified handling .
- Lockout/Tagout Required – Indicates that equipment must be de-energized and tagged before maintenance .
- Disconnect Before Servicing – Instructs workers to isolate power before opening the panel .
- Instructional Labels – Provide step-by-step guidance for safe operation, shutdown, or restart of the panel .

Design and Placement Guidelines

- Color Coding: Red for immediate danger, yellow for caution, and orange for arc flash hazards; green for instructional labels .
 - Text and Font: Large, bold, and concise text ensures readability even in low-light conditions .
 - Pictograms: Standardized symbols (ANSI Z535) communicate hazards universally, regardless of language .
 - Durability: Labels should resist fading, moisture, and wear, typically lasting 8–12 years under normal conditions .
- #### Regulatory Compliance
- NEC (National Electrical Code): Articles 110.22(A) and 408.4(A) require clear identification of circuits and panel directories .
 - OSHA: 1910.303(e) mandates proper labeling in commercial and industrial settings to ensure safe maintenance .
 - NFPA: Provides standards for electrical safety and labeling to prevent accidents and ensure emergency preparedness .
